

The Last Age Group Championships 2008

The last of the age group championships 2008 for Bridlington Swimming Club were held at Leisure World on Friday 28th. March.

The Individual Medlays are one length for the 9&10 or two lengths for all other age groups of Fly, Backstroke, Breaststroke and Front crawl.

Of the 34 swims 25 were PB times.

William Dennis completed the five events taking the club record in every one, a terrific achievement.

His time for the 100m IM of 1.23.74 took 2 seconds off the old record held by Richard Butler.

Matthew Nelson was just 0.48 of a second outside the 200m record which has been held by Jeremy Eckles since 1999.
